

Dear Parents

Key Stage 4 l'Ardèche Adventure Trip - Saturday 23 July to Sunday 31 July 2022

I am pleased to inform you of an exciting opportunity being provided for Key Stage 4 students to experience a challenging water sports and adventure holiday in the south of France. The trip is organised with Acorn Adventure, a leading schools adventure tour firm, who are fully bonded with ABTA, ATOL and the School and Group Travel Association. Acorn Adventure has also been awarded the Learning Outside the Classroom Quality Badge for its Ardèche Centre.

I have made a booking for a nine-day trip at the end of the summer term 2022. **The trip will depart on Saturday 23**rd **July and return on Sunday 31**st **July 2022.** Will will leave Sherburn High School via the New Lane entrance on Saturday afternoon (time to be confirmed once ferry times have been arranged) and travel for 20 hours to the south of France. On Sunday morning, we will complete our journey at Acorn's centre at Ruoms. The centre is well equipped and based in a delightful wooded campsite in the Rhône Alps region in France.

The stunning location known as *The Grand Canyon of Europe* is in the Ardèche region of the south of France. The highlight of the trip will be a two-day, 30km canoe descent of the mighty l'Ardèche River which runs down a spectacular gorge with sides that in places rise to 300 metres above the river. The descent will be spent navigating the difficult river rapids, challenging rock jumps and will spend our evening at an overnight bivouac site set in the remarkable landscape. No previous canoeing experience is required as we will be expertly looked after by the highly recommended Acorn River Team who have over 30 years experience on the river.

The remainder of the trip will be shorter activities based at superb locations within a short distance from the centre. These activities will include kayaking, abseiling, raft building, river trekking, swimming and visiting the local village of Ruoms. We will also spend a day at the beautiful Vallon Pont d'Arc. There are also a range of evening activities put on by the centre staff.

This trip is open to all students who are currently in Year 9 and Year 10.

Included in the price of the trip will be:

- Travel by executive coach and ferry crossing
- Fully comprehensive insurance
- Use of all specialist equipment such as canoes, buoyancy aids, rafts etc
- Tents, beds and site fees
- All meals whilst at the centre
- Full instruction and supervision of activities

Not included in the price of the trip:

- Sleeping bag and pillow
- Spending money for drinks, snacks and gifts (plus food for the journeys)
- Towels
- Swimming gear

This is an exciting opportunity which will benefit students both educationally and socially. The total cost of this Adventure Holiday is £627 per student.

A non-refundable deposit of £65 MUST be paid by Monday 31 May 2021.

- a. Instalment 1: £150 by Saturday 31 July 2021
- b. Instalment 2: £150 by Sunday 31 October 2021















- c. Instalment 3: £150 by Monday 28 February 2022
- d. Instalment 4: £112 by Saturday 30 April 2022

The price is based on achieving 75 students to make a Village group. If you wish your child to participate can you please make arrangements to pay by debit/credit card on the parentpay website at **www.parentpay.com**, give consent and provide details of any medical conditions and also an emergency contact number. If you have not received an activation letter to log onto parentpay, please contact the school as soon as possible and we can arrange to send one out to you. **Your child will not be allowed on the trip until payment is received together with the requested contact and medical information.**

This visit is organised under the school's educational visits policy. To give consent for your child to take part in the visit please tick the consent box when paying for the trip. A copy of the consent information is attached (for your information only) and can also be found on the school website under the main menu on the left hand side in the "parentpay" section. Please read the detailed information for this trip before giving consent. You will not need to send the form to school as long as you have **provided an emergency contact number and any medical conditions in the note box against the payment transaction line.**

All students taking part in the activity will be covered by the North Yorkshire County Council Personal Accident and Travel Insurance. If you wish to have details of this cover please contact the Business Manager.

Should you wish to withdraw at a later date, please do so in writing. The Tour firm will not refund the first deposit and the first two instalments once paid and then has a sliding penalty for the subsequent instalments, depending on time remaining (monies can be reclaimable through the insurance company due to illness only with written confirmation from your doctor).

Please do think carefully before making a commitment to this trip. If you do wish to withdraw your son/daughter at a later date there may be a student willing to take their place, but please understand the position if this is not the case. I will do my best on your behalf; however loss of all or part of the trip cost can result.

Sanctions:

On receiving an application I will discuss that student's suitability to join this trip with their respective Head of House. Should your child accrue 5 or more C3 sanctions at any time prior to the trip departing, they will be removed from the trip and you will lose the non-refundable deposit together with any other instalments paid that cannot be recovered from the tour operator. I am sure you will appreciate good behaviour is extremely important when taking students out of school for health and safety reasons.

PARENTAL CONSENT STATEMENT

Please arrange for payment via the parentpay website www.parentpay.com and provide emergency contact details including your home number and a mobile phone number. Your child will not be accepted on the trip without consent, emergency contact details and payment.

MEDICAL CONSENT STATEMENT

My child is in good health and does not suffer from any condition requiring regular treatment or any complaint that may require emergency treatment and will not be excluded from any activities. I confirm that:-

- 1. There are no activities that I do not wish my child to take part in.
- My child does not suffer from any condition requiring regular treatment
- 3. My child does not suffer from any condition which may require emergency treatment
- 4. I give my consent to any emergency medical treatment necessary during the course of the visit.

If your child does have medical problems please let us know via the parentpay website by including details of the condition and what action we would need to take if applicable in the **note box** prior to sending your payment. This needs to be done for every trip irrespective of whether the school has previously been informed.

For insurance purposes, if your child suffers from a serious complaint, please send a letter to the school enclosing a letter from your doctor confirming your child is fit to participate giving details of the complaint and its treatment. Please note this in the box prior to making payment so that we know we are expecting a doctors letter.

If we do not receive notes via parentpay regarding any medical conditions, we will assume there are no medical conditions and no restrictions to the activities your child can participate in during the visit.

COLLECTION ARRANGEMENTS CONSENT (if applicable)

I understand that the return time is after normal school hours. I will arrange for a responsible person to collect my son / daughter from the **school bus park** on **New Lane** where necessary.

The letter inviting your child on the school trip will inform you if the trip is returning after normal school hours together with an approximate return time. That information is also on the top of this form.
