Coursework 35%

You develop a series of documents for an existing business the aim of which is demonstrate that you understand how the business markets itself & that you can use the advanced features of software to develop these documents. The documents are:

- A 2 sided A4 brochure
- A 6 slide Presentation
- A merged letter & database
- A study of compression techniques

The coursework is expected to take around 15 weeks and is then self-assessed and a final assessment given by your teacher.

Exam 65%

The exam is 2 ¼ hours and covers 12 areas of IT theory. There are 10 questions on the exam. The exam is usually taken in June.

A2 ICT

Coursework 35%

You develop a relational database for a client and document the process throughout. The database should solve a real problem within an organisation and you need to provide evidence of:

- Background research
- Systems analysis & design
- Development of the database
- A user guide
- A Technical document

The coursework is expected to take around 10 weeks and is then self-assessed and a final assessment given by your teacher.

Exam 65%

The exam is 2 ½ hours and covers 10 areas of IT theory. There are also 10 questions on the exam so each area of theory is examined. The exam is usually taken in June.

The A2 textbook covers all of the IT theory topics and is used extensively in lessons.
